### Costs:

- All subsidised courses have a nominal fee of £50 to cover the cost of examination and registration
- If a candidate fails to complete a subsidised course then a charge of £100 will be made to cover the cost of the work book and facilitation

### To be eligible for LSC funding a learner must meet the following criteria:

- Must be employed or volunteering
- The learner must have been resident in the UK or EU for 3 or more years (the learner can be a refugee or asylum seeker with relevant supporting paperwork)
- All learners from outside the UK or EU must produce paperwork to support residency or right to work in the UK or EU
- The learner should NOT be studying for another government funded course, however self funding is acceptable.
