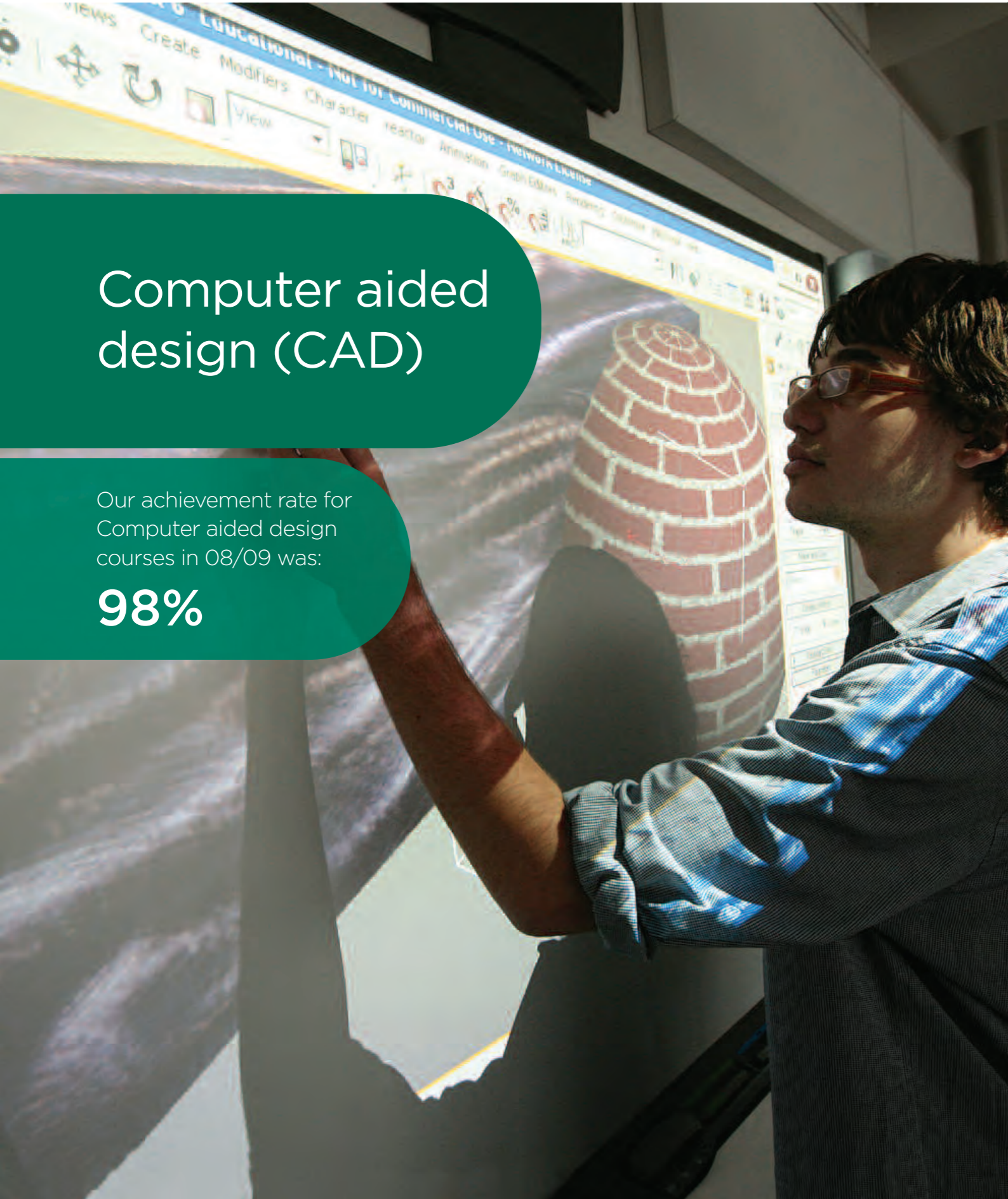


# Computer aided design (CAD)
